Data is solely on African American students. Morse part of a SDCOE Equity Grant. Morse is focusing on improving the academic achievement of our African American subgroup. African American data shared: SBAC data, D and F data, suspension data, graduation rate. This data will be monitored during the 2019/2020 and used to make informed decisions to support our African American subgroup as well as other subgroups.
5. SPSA ➤ Review of 2019-2020 SPSA	• Informational: Dr. Larkin, Principal	• Dr. Larkin reviewed the SPSA and explained how the SPSA goals are aligned to our budgeted Title I monies. There is approximately \$141,000 left to spend in the 2019-2020 school year. Larkin also reviewed the SIX goals in the SPSA which are connected to the CA Healthy Kids Survey, SBAC, D and F data, etc Goals are targeted with strategies and money to support each strategy. Morse's budget must align with SPSA.
