The Council unanimously approved Mrs. Benedicto as the 2018-2019 replacement for the vacant classroom teacher position.

Dr. Larkin emailed staff and asked staff to announce the vacancies to their students. Samantha Abano volunteered to fill one of the 2018-2019 student representative vacancies. The council will continue to recruit for the other student representative vacancy.

4. Data Review ➤ 2018 Official SBAC Data ➤ P1 GPA/D and F Data	• Informational: Dr. Cynthia Larkin, Principal	• SBAC data: The 2018 SBAC data was shared with the Council. Students did not meet the 5% increase in ELA goal the Council set for growth. There was a 5% decrease in ELA from 57% in 2017 to 52% in 2018. However, students did meet and exceed the Math goal the Council set for growth. Students improved by 6% from 23% to 29%. Subgroup data shows that African American students' scores increased by 4% in ELA and the Filipino subgroup increased by 10% in math.

		• Our graduation goal includes D & F data. Data shows that for the P1 grading period, 9th graders are receiving the highest amount of Ds and Fs in their classes. African Americans and Latino students are receiving the highest amount of Ds and Fs in their classes.
5. SPSA➤ Review Goals in Relation to Recent SBAC and D and F Data	• Informational: Dr. Cynthia Larkin, Principal	• We will use our most updated SBAC data to determine our 2019-2020 SPSA goals. We will focus on literacy across the curriculum. That is writing and reading in all courses. Overall, we had more decreases than increases. Our math scores increased. Our literacy scores decrease.
6. SDUSD LCAP Review ➤ LCAP Survey	• Informational: Dr. Cynthia Larkin, Principal	• District has asked for feedback on the LCAP. The Council reviewed the LCAP and focused on the areas we considered most valuable and least valuable. On Goal 1: Closing the Achievement Gap and High Expectations of All Students, we considered all goals valuable. Goal 2: Access to Broad and Challenging Curriculum, we questioned the amount of money budgeted in this area and feel that the district should increase the budget to support the outlined goals in this area. Goal 3: Quality Leadership, Teaching and Learning: we think the district

		should continue the budget allocation on 3.3, 3.4 and 3.5. Goal 4: Positive School Environment Climate and Culture: we agreed more money needs to be allocated for safe and secure schools. Goal 5: Family & Community Engagement with Highly-Regarded Neighborhood Schools, we also feel that more budget should be allocated to support the objectives in this area. Dr. Larkin will submit the Council's feedback via the Survey Monkey link.
